

UCI-CHOC PEDIATRIC FELLOWSHIPS

The Children's Hospital of Orange County (CHOC) is the only freestanding children's hospital in Orange County, with 334 inpatient beds, 30 PICU beds, 12 Cardiovascular ICU beds and 92 NICU beds. It is also a regional referral center and level 1 trauma center. There are more than 95,000 ED visits per year, along with a busy outpatient experience. Most of the clinical experience occurs at CHOC; rotations at UCI or other sites are also available. There is protected time for research or quality improvement projects at either CHOC or UCI.

Conferences include specialty-specific core lectures, patient case conferences, board review, team rounds, journal clubs, simulation and procedure labs, the Fellow Core Curriculum, and participation in M&Ms and hospital committees. In addition, there are multiple opportunities to teach residents and medical students.

The Fellows' Core Curriculum covers topics such as work-life balance/wellness, cultural competency, health disparities, giving feedback, research basics (biostats, study design, IRBs, grants), quality improvement, managing difficult conversations, medical ethics, how to teach, and how to find a job after fellowship.
