- 25 categorical pediatrics and 2 child neurology residents per year.
- Strong fellowship matches across the nation.
- 93% board pass rate averaged over 5 years for first-time test takers well above national means (100% pass rate in 2023).
- Community engagement and advocacy skill-building opportunities enable residents to grow into capable physician- advocates and to become champions in disparities and leaders for child health.
- 7 resident continuity clinics throughout our surrounding communities with a diverse patient population, including opportunities to rotate in our federally qualified health clinic.
- Career tracks in primary care, hospital medicine, critical care, subspecialty, and research.
- Residents in the Primary Care Pathway benefit from one-on-one mentorship by a community-based primary care pediatrician.
- LEAD 4 IMPACT pathway for residents seeking advanced leadership skill-building in the domains of medical education, advocacy, and healthcare administration with robust faculty mentorship from hospital- and university-based leaders.
- STAR Scholar pathway for residents seeking the necessary skills to address health disparities through scholarly research using a comprehensive infrastructure and robust mentorship.
